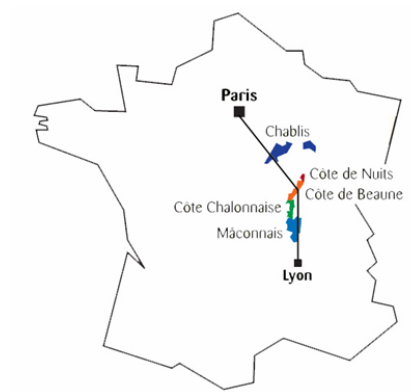
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The *régional* BOURGOGNE Pinot Noir appellation is probably the best introduction to the world of Burgundy red wines, providing an authentic expression of this classic varietal. Reputed to be particularly fragile and difficult to grow, Pinot Noir here produces a wine with a light ruby color with delightful aromas of red berries.



PRODUCTION AREA: A blend from three plots located on the Côte de Nuits and the Côte de Beaune.

TECHNIQUES: The grapes are hand-picked and destalked, and the wine aged in French oak for 11 months. Gentle filtering and low sulfur dosage.

TASTING NOTES: Intense ruby red in color, with aromas tending to fresh and juicy fruit with lightly roasted notes. Marrying structure and liveliness, it offers remarkable balance for a *régionale* appellation. This is an indulgent wine that is suited to any occasion.

KEEPING POTENTIAL: Pleasant when drunk young, and can be kept for two to three years.

SERVING TEMPERATURE: 15-17°C
